Commemorative Memorabilia
Military Police Memorial Grove at Ft. Leonard Wood, MO

1. Purpose. To prescribe policies and procedures for MP Commemorative Plaques in the Memorial Grove.

2. Applicability. This regulation applies to all active and reserve elements of the U.S. Army Military Police Corps and to all members of the Military Police Corps Regiment.

3. Commemorative Plaques.

a. Commemorative Wall at Memorial Grove. Space remains on the wall of the Military Police Memorial Grove for the emplacement of organizational plaques to commemorate the sacrifice of military police who died in service of our nation.

b. Units authorized to emplace plaques. Military Police separate Companies, Battalions, and Brigades with credit in support of any Army operation are eligible to order a plaque. Units without credit for service in Army operations(s), but have had elements within their unit deployed will also be considered eligible. Commanders are responsible to follow the below guidelines:

(1) Battalion and Brigade plaques: No larger than 24 inches long by 20 inches high; no more than 300 words total; raised edge with ½" wide border; Helvetica letters upper and lower case, centered.

(2) Separate MP Company plaques: No larger than 18 inches long by 15 inches high; no more than 300 words total; raised edge with ½" wide border; Helvetica letters upper and lower case, centered.

c. Requesting the plaque. Information forwarded to MPRA should include dimensions of plaque, wording, and desired date of mounting. A diagram of the plaque, as close to scale as possible must accompany the request. Suggested format for the plaque is provided at Figure 1 below. Plaques shall be purchased by forwarding the request to:

d. Payment of costs for plaque production.

(1) The Military Police Regimental Association (MPRA) oversees the collection of money for all commemorative plaque requests. When the request is received a cost estimate will be obtained from an approved vendor and returned to the requesting command.

(2) The MPRA will coordinate the approval of all requests with USAMPS. The USAMPS Commandant and RCSM are the approving authority for selection of plaques displayed on the wall.

(3) When payment is received the plaque will be ordered.

4. Other memorial options.

a. The MPRA also offers the following options to honor individual or unit service.

(1) Memorial Bricks. Bricks start at \$50 for 4x8" brick.

(2) Memorial Trees. Trees come with a 6x8 inch bronze plaque with the name of the individual or group being honored. Prices for trees start at \$700 (plaque included).

(3) Memorial Benches. Prices for the benches start at \$1000 on the MPRA website at www.mpraonline.org or call 573-329-6772 for further information.

b. The MPRA is the approval authority for the designs and layout of the above options. Once the design is approved and the money order has been turned in to MPRA, the work order on the tree, brick or bench order(s) will be placed.
